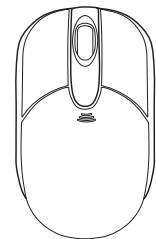

1 Unpacking

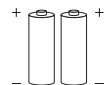
Remove all packaging from the unit. Retain the packaging. If you dispose of it, please do so according to the local regulations. The following items are included:

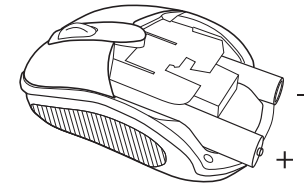
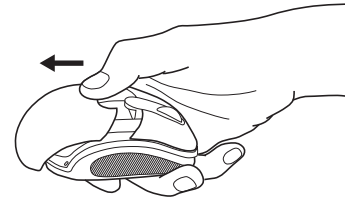

2 Install the Batteries

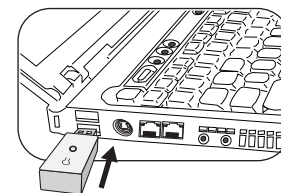


Slide the battery cover off and insert 2 x AAA batteries. Close the battery cover. Ensure batteries are inserted with the correct polarity.

3 Connect the USB Receiver

Plug the USB receiver directly into your computer's USB port.

The red LED light will illuminate.

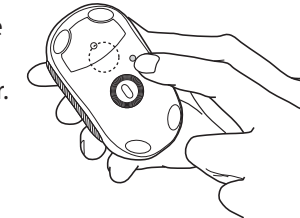

4 Activate the Wireless Mouse

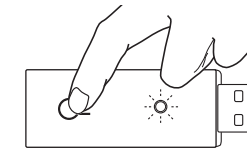
Press the **Connect** button on both the mouse and the USB receiver to activate the connection between the mouse and the USB receiver.

Note : For energy saving, press and hold the **Connect** button on the mouse for 3 seconds to temporarily turn off the mouse and its connections with the USB receiver. Press the **Connect** button again to turn it back on.

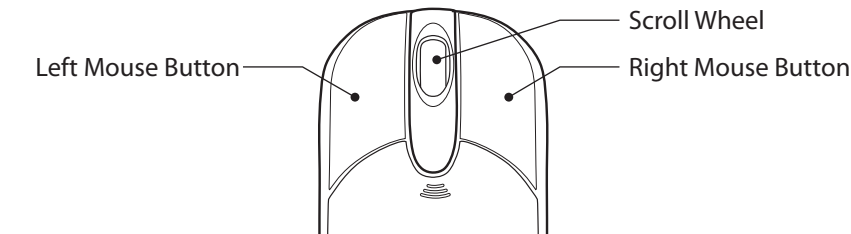


Flashing Red LED Light

When the USB receiver and the mouse are connected and in use, the red LED light on the USB receiver will flash.

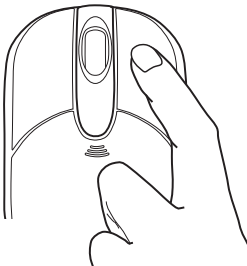

6 Sleep Mode Function

After the mouse has been in on idle state for 8 minutes, it will go into Sleep Mode.

To reactivate the mouse, click on either the **Right** or the **Left** mouse button.




7 Troubleshooting

Mouse Not Working :

1. Make sure the USB receiver is plugged into a USB port and the computer is on.
2. Check battery installation. Replace batteries if needed.
3. If mouse performance is slow or intermittent around a wireless network, unplug the USB receiver from the USB port and then reinsert it. Press the **Connect** button again on the bottom of the mouse to reactivate it.

8 Safety

Optical :
Never point the optical sensor towards the face, particularly the eyes, to avoid possible injury.

 While the mouse is functioning, the optical light is visible to the naked eye. Be careful not to look directly into the emitter hole while the mouse is active.

Wireless Devices :
Before boarding any aircraft or packing a wireless device in luggage that will be checked, remove the batteries from the wireless device. Wireless devices can transmit radio frequency (RF) energy, whenever batteries are installed and the wireless device is turn on.

Battery-Powered Devices :
Improper use of batteries may result in battery fluid leakage, overheating, or explosion. Released battery fluid is corrosive and may be toxic. It can cause skin and eye burns, and is harmful if swallowed.

8 Safety

To reduce the risk of injury :

- Keep batteries out of the reach of children.
